Monterey Bay Aquarium Behavior Contract

The Monterey Bay Aquarium is a place of learning, fun and discovery! To make sure that all visitors have a great time at the Aquarium, it is important to abide by these behavior expectations:

- **Stay with your group and always be with a buddy.** Students and adult chaperones must stay with their group at all times inside the Aquarium, out on the deck, and if permitted in the Aquarium in gift and book stores.
- **Be courteous and respectful of other visitors.** Talk quietly and walk through the Aquarium. Do not run.
- **Use the stairs, leaving elevators available for those who need them.** Do not play on the escalator.
- **Be respectful of the Aquarium exhibits and building.** Use books or clipboards to write against, instead of walls, windows or exhibit labels. Do not climb on exhibits or railings.
- **Help care for the animals.** When permitted, touch them gently. Do not disturb them by tapping on the windows. Also, do not feed birds on the deck or at the picnic area.
- **Keep food, drinks and gum outside the Aquarium.** School groups are not allowed to eat sack lunches or drink beverages in the Aquarium, on the benches in front of the Great Tide Pool or on any deck areas. This includes the Portola Café and the seating area outside the café dining room near the otter exhibit.
- **Please respect our Aquarium neighbors.** Paly Groups are NOT permitted to visit merchants on Cannery Row for any reason.

Consequences: Student who violate this contract will be given detention, and in some cases parents might be contacted.
