WHAT IS TEAM?

TEAM classes comprise the core academic subjects of English, World History, and Biology. Students in the program take these classes with a mix of all TEAM students, sharing the same teachers.

In TEAM classes, students learn the same curriculum and are held to the same standards as all Paly freshmen. TEAM classes are held in normal subject-area classrooms. TEAM students take math, world language, physical education, and electives with the rest of the Paly freshman class outside of TEAM.

TEAM teachers have an aligned prep period when they meet weekly to discuss the progress of students and collaborate on the organization of various off-campus interdisciplinary activities and student social events.

TEAM's focus on building connections between students, teachers, upperclassmen, and parents increases Developmental Assets while providing a top-notch Palo Alto High School education.

TEAM students go on to fulfill leadership positions at Paly and in their communities, such as those within student government, journalism, Link Crew, and more.

Parents can be involved in their student's freshman year at any level - chaperone, board member, or supportive parent.
